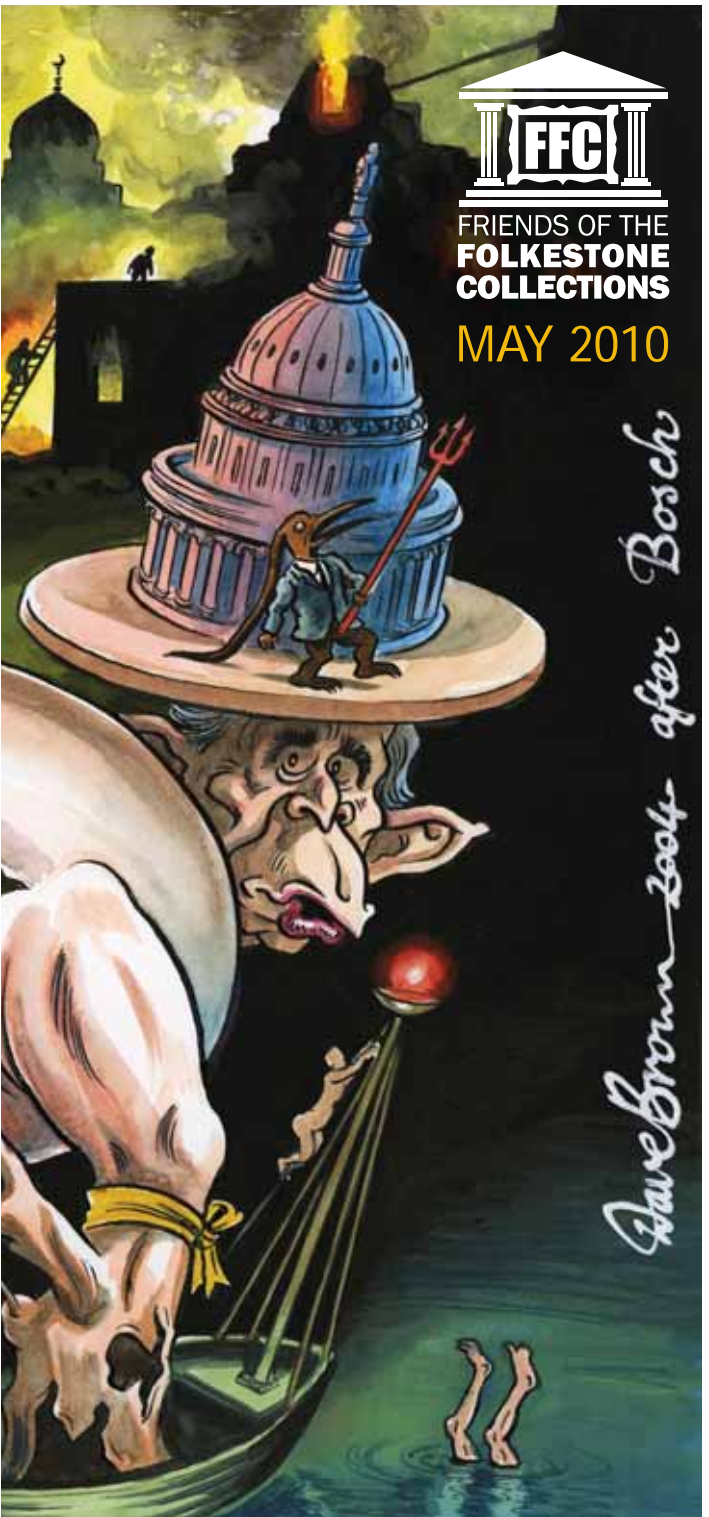

About the Artist:

Dave Brown – A Visual Journalist

Kent Born Dave Brown trained as a fine artist but after winning The Sunday Times Political Cartoon Competition in 1989 he became a full time cartoonist with work appearing in *The Guardian*, *The Express*, *The Scotsman*, *The Economist* and *Financial Times* amongst others. His work can create fierce controversy in the tradition of robust British cartoonists stemming from James Gilray in the eighteenth century.

Dave Brown will give an illustrated lecture on how he reworked the Old Masters as the foundation of his cartoons and how he copes with the short timescales allowed for topical cartoons.
