## H.G. Wells Short Story Competition Entry Form

CONDITIONS: It's a Winner-Take-All competition, the Finalist receiving the award of £1000. It is part of the annual H G Wells Festival, centred at The Grand, Folkestone, & celebrating the most productive decade of his career when he lived in Sandgate, Kent. But Nominations for the annual award will be publicly announced, and all Nominees will be invited to the final Announcement and Award Ceremony on Sunday, 20 September 2009.

STYLE: The Bequestor's conditions are for a story of between 1000 and 5000 words in the style of H G Wells and preferably located in the Folkestone\ Sandgate\ Hythe\ New Romney area. Manuscripts must be handwritten, preferably in joined-up writing. The Bequestor considers this an important part of literacy, and many authors find that composing this way aids concentration. Wells 'style' can be described as lighthearted, perhaps humorous, in clear prose.

WHO QUALIFIES TO ENTER? There is no age limit. The competition aims to encourage creativity and the promotion of budding talent. Manuscripts, plus a computer printout if desired, must be sent to Somerville Lodge, Hillside, Sandgate, Kent, CT20 3DB by 20 July. Please retain a copy of your entry as originals cannot be returned.
