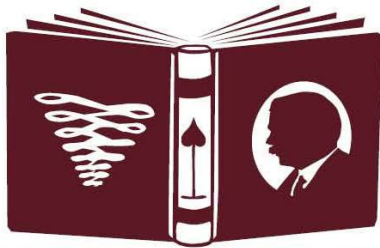

RULES

1. **The brief:** The first H.G. Wells Festival four years ago was themed around *The Sea Lady*, Wells's novel of 1902; the **theme** of this year's competition is The Sea.
2. Entries must be entirely **your own work**, and no part must have been previously published or broadcast in any format. Plagiarism is not to be tolerated.
3. Please submit each entry, **typed double spaced** on A4 paper with page numbers. **Also** please include a version of your story **in your own handwriting** – although this is not compulsory, 10% of the marks are awarded by the judges for good handwriting.
4. A **separate entry form** is required **for each entry**, so multiple entries require multiple forms.
5. **Scripts must not contain any indication of the entrant's identity** – scripts will be coded on receipt, and the judges will only be able to refer to the codes, not the entry forms.
6. Scripts must be written **in English**, although all words that would be intelligible to a cultivated English reader are accepted.
7. The **judges' decisions** concerning admissibility, shortlisting and awards are **final and binding**.
8. Entrants acknowledge that if shortlisted their **entries may be published** on the Wells Festival website, in the Anthology (of which entrants will receive a free copy – further copies available at £10 each), and the whole or extracts in Wells Festival publicity material.
9. Competition **entries will not be returned**.
10. **Entries submitted by agents will not be accepted**.
11. The competition is open to UK residents only, and it should be noted that **those nominated** to be considered for a prize are **expected to attend the prizegiving** at The Grand in Folkestone, viz:
