HUNDREDS of vintage vehicles and classic cars were on display for all to see over the Bank Holiday weekend.

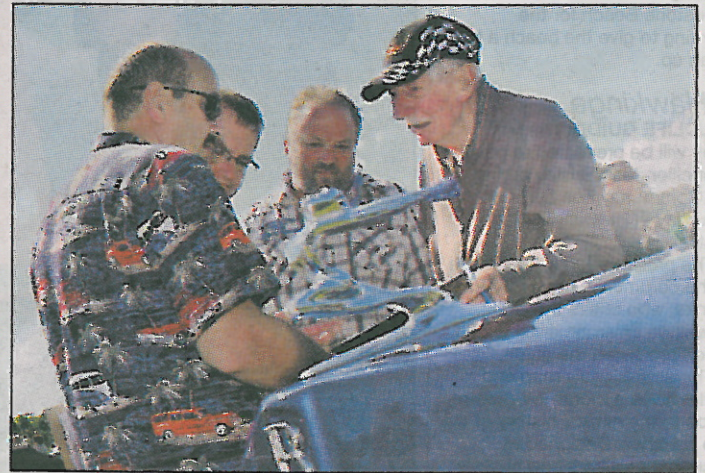
Historic motors and bikes and limited edition sports cars and limousines were lined up along The Leas as the Oldtimer Rally returned to Folkestone.
