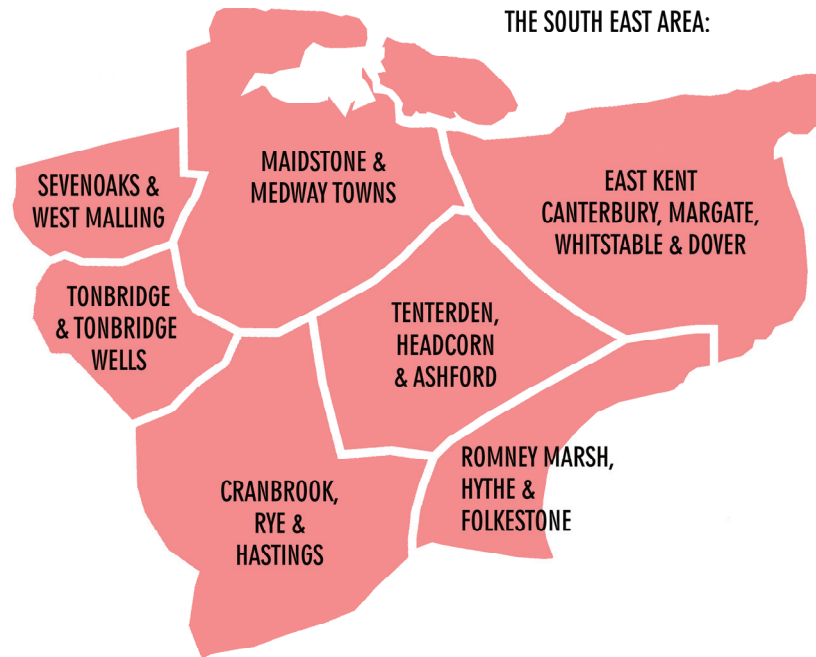

# SOUTH EAST SUMMER EXHIBITION



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All works will be selected by the judging panel and its decision will be final.
2. Each artist by entering a work confirms they hold copyright and intellectual property rights and grant the Friends of the Folkestone Collections permission to reproduce the work for publicity associated with the exhibition
3. Artists are advised to insure their works as the committee cannot accept any liability for loss or damage arising from submission or exhibition of their works.
4. Successful entrants will be informed either by post, E-mail or telephone.
5. Unsuccessful entrants will be asked to collect their works prior to the exhibition opening: Between - 10am - 4pm on the 1st or 2nd July, from the North Entrance to The Grand, in Metropole East Road, Folkestone, CT20 2XL
6. All works must be suitably framed for Hanging; 'Box Canvases' are accepted but Glass and Perspex Clip frames are not acceptable.  
D-rings must be attached to the back of the frame 1/3rd from the top; no string or wire.
7. Works should be within the acceptable maximum size limits (including frame) of 180cm × 180cm.
8. The committee regrets that on this occasion it cannot accept sculpture, ceramics or installations.
9. Diptychs count as two works. Because of limited space triptychs are not acceptable.
10. Prints should be original limited editions. Please note on entry form number of edition, plus price framed and unframed
11. Photographs must be limited editions printed by the artist .



## SOUTH EAST SUMMER EXHIBITION

### COMPLETING THE ENTRY FORM

1. APPLICATION FORMS must be returned by 14th June 2011.
2. ENTRIES to be accompanied by a £10 fee per work submitted (non refundable).  
Cheques made payable to: Friends of the Folkestone collections SESE .
3. MEDIUMS should be clearly stated, e.g. drawing: Pencil, wash, ink etc.  
PRINTS: State method(s) used e.g. woodblock, etching.  
PHOTOGRAPHS: Limited editions printed by the artist, for editions: number of editions,  
Price framed and unframed. \*All entries must be for sale.
4. PRICES: Remember to include 30% commission plus VAT if you are registered. Price  
Changes may not be made during the exhibition, nor exhibits be removed.
5. SALES: The Committee will administer sales, placing red dots on sold items. Payments  
Minus commission will be issued by cheque to the named artist.
6. INVIGILATION ROTA: The Exhibition will be open everyday between 9th July-4th August and  
be invigilated at all times. If you are able to invigilate any morning 10am – 1pm, or  
afternoon 1pm- 5pm, session please indicate on the application form, and we will contact you  
to arrange this.

### SUCCESSFUL ENTRANTS

- Successful entrants will receive 1 years membership to Friends of the Folkestone collections, usual price £10, and an invitation to the summer exhibition preview, garden party.
- All sales are subject to a payment of 30% commission to FFC.
- Unsold entries must be collected by or on behalf of the Artist on the 5th or 6th of August between 10am – 4pm. \*Receipts must be produced.

### UNSUCCESSFUL ENTRANTS

- Unsuccessful entrants will receive 1 Years free membership to Friends of the Folkestone - Collections.
- Entries not selected for this year's exhibition must be collected by or on behalf of the artist on the 1st or 2nd July between 10am -4 pm. We have very limited space and have no room to store your pictures.
- Receipts must be produced.

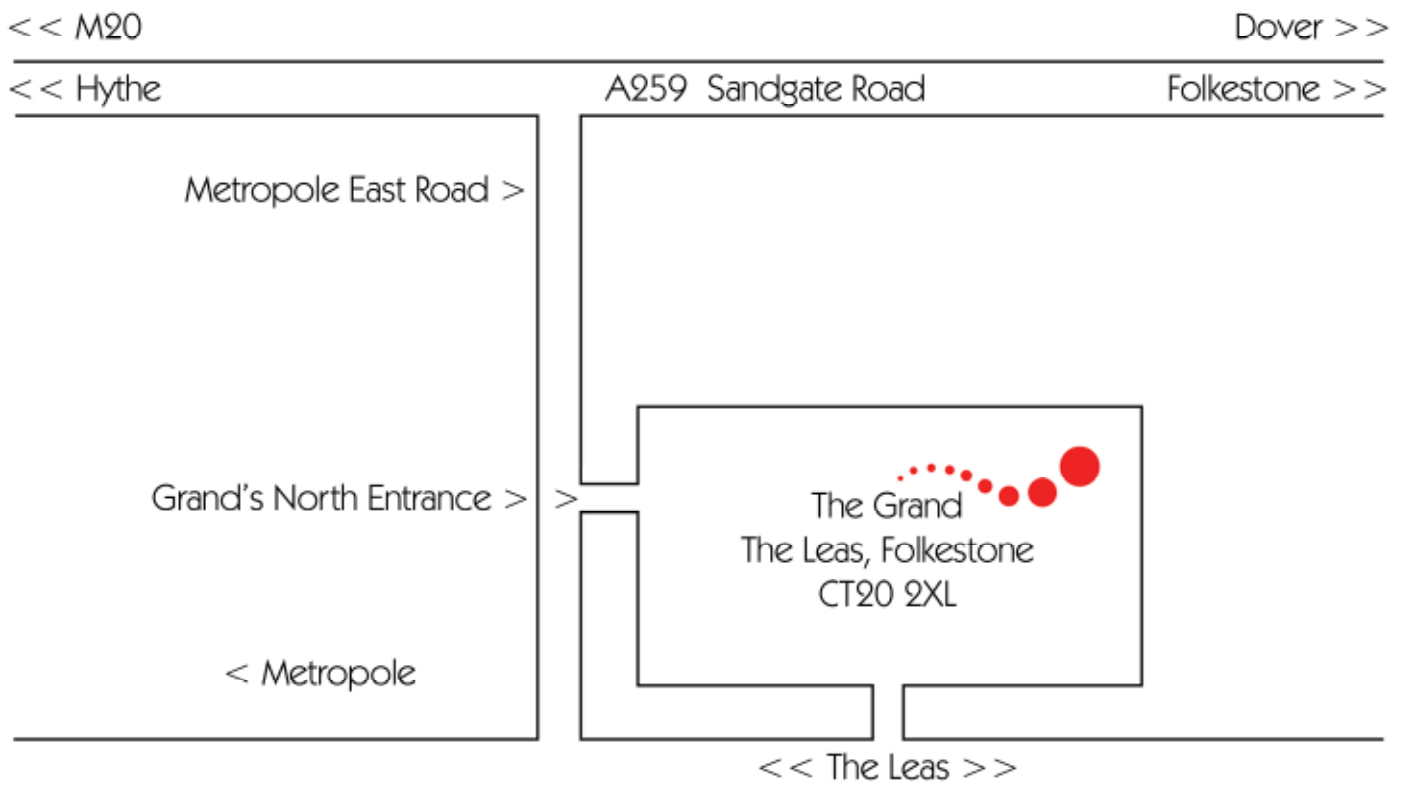
